As from 2013 a One-to-One iPad program will be implemented for students in Years 4-6. Students are encouraged to participate in extra curricula activities; including the performing arts, learning of musical instruments, sporting activities and community activities planned by the local Council and community organisations. St Pius X community members take the values lived by Jesus Christ as the foundation of everything we do. We believe that Christ is reflected in the lives of each and every person within the school community.
