



## Week 5


### Important notices:

### This week in Kindy:

This week in Kindy we have been learning all about **friends**. It is important that good friends are kind to each other, share, help and say nice things.

We read the books: The Rainbow Fish and The Bucket Filler.



We spent a lot of this week focusing on the important message in The Rainbow Fish. We made our own Rainbow Fish to remind us how it is important to treat our friends nicely. We also made friendship bracelets that we wore to represent that we are all friends in kindy.



This week we also spoke about Lent. We are beginning to understand that Jesus loved us very much and that Easter time is when we celebrate His love for us. Tuesday was Shrove Tuesday so we made pancakes that we topped with our favourite things.



This week we also started to develop our STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) skills by trying to create an effective marble maze. The students discussed and discovered how to get the marble through a maze using ramps.
